New Private Approval-Compliant Degree Program Psychology at FHM

Jan has sent us the following information:

The private Fachhochschule des Mittelstands (FHM) has been offering the Bachelor's degree programme 'Psychology' at its sites in Bielefeld, Bamberg and Hanover for 2 years – in addition to the well-known 'Psychology' degree programme: <a href="https://www.fh-mittelstand.de/studies/psychology-clinical/full-time/">https://www.fh-mittelstand.de/studies/psychology-clinical/full-time/</a>. Special feature: The study programme 'Psychology' takes place in cooperation with the British University of Gloucestershire and entitles students to take up a further master's programme with the aim of obtaining approval in psychotherapy at a German university (according to PsychThG and PsychThApprO). The total cost of the studies is approximately EUR 32,000. The prerequisite is the general university entrance qualification (FHR is not sufficient) as well as English



skills of at least B2, which can be proven by the HZB. Approximately 20% of the studies are taught in English, in total students have to study in the UK for about 2 weeks – the rest of the studies take place at the above locations (2 days/week presence, 2 days/week online, 1 day free).
